01 BREAKTHROUGH

The duo's debut album arrived in 2016 and produced three songs that reached the top of Canada's Franco Pop charts: Quand T'es Pas Là, Attends-Moi and Pleure Pas. Their growing profile led to a recording agreement with Ultra Records (Sony New York).

02 INTERNATIONAL RECOGNITION

Quand T'es Pas Là gained further attention in Europe and was remixed by internationally known DJs including DJ Antoine. Le Rendez-Vous was featured in the popular Netflix series Shadowhunters, extending the duo's music to a wider international audience.

03 LIVE HIGHLIGHTS

Lidya & Sebastien have appeared at prestigious occasions and destinations including the Cannes Film Festival, the Monaco Yacht Show, a private evening at Palais Es Saadi in Marrakech, the Hotel Café in Los Angeles and The St. Regis Bora Bora.

04 ARTISTIC EVOLUTION

Traveling Shoes, released in 2022, brought collaborations with acclaimed industry figures Jacquire King and Sterloid. In 2025, the duo opened a new creative chapter with Rodeo, a bold project shaped by powerful melodies, heartfelt lyrics and cinematic production.
